
PRIVACY POLICY

BACKGROUND:

This Policy applies as between you, the User of this Website or of any of our games accessed by smartphone, tablet or other device and The Mathematical Games Company Limited ('MGC;') the owner and provider of this Website. This Policy applies to our use of any and all Data collected by us in relation to your use of the Website.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

In this Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“Data”	means collectively all information that you submit to the MGC via the Website. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the Data Protection Act 1998;
“Cookie”	means a small text file placed on your computer by this Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website. Details of the cookies used by this Website are set out in Clause 12;
“MGC”	means The Mathematical Games Company Limited Registered in England No. 08093051 Registered office -1-7 Park Road Caterham Surrey CR3 5TB;
“UK and EU Cookie Law”	means the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 as amended by the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2011;
“User”	means any third party that accesses the Website and is not employed by MGC and acting in the course of their employment; and
“Website”	means the website that you are currently using (www.czeuspuzzles.com).

2. Scope of this Policy

This Policy applies only to the actions of MGC and Users with respect to this Website. It does not extend to any websites that can be accessed from this Website including, but not limited to, any links we may provide to social media websites.

3. Data Collected

Without limitation, any of the following Data may be collected by this Website or by use of our apps (including server game data) from time to time:

- 3.1 name;
- 3.2 date of birth;

- 3.3 gender;
- 3.4 job title;
- 3.5 profession;
- 3.6 contact information such as email addresses and telephone numbers;
- 3.7 demographic information such as post code, preferences and interests;
- 3.8 financial information such as credit / debit card numbers;
- 3.9 IP address (automatically collected);
- 3.10 web browser type and version (automatically collected);
- 3.11 operating system (automatically collected);
- 3.12 a list of URLs starting with a referring site, your activity on this Website, and the site you exit to (automatically collected).
- 3.13 When you purchase Services on our website(s), we may collect certain payment information from you on behalf of our payment service providers, but this information is temporarily cached in a way that is unreadable by us. When you purchase items via our apps (such as those you can purchase in the App Store, the Windows Store, via Amazon Kindle or on Google Play) we do not collect or store any payment information from you.

4. Our Use of Data

- 4.1 Any personal Data you submit will be retained by MGC for 6 months.
- 4.2 Unless we are obliged or permitted by law to do so, and subject to Clause 5, your Data will not be disclosed to third parties. This does not include our affiliates and / or other companies within our group.
- 4.3 All personal Data is stored securely in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998. For more details on security see Clause 11 below.
- 4.4 Any or all of the above Data may be required by us from time to time in order to provide you with the best possible service and experience when using our Website. Specifically, Data may be used by us for the following reasons:
 - 4.4.1 internal record keeping;
 - 4.4.2 improvement of our products / services;
 - 4.4.3 transmission by email of promotional materials that may be of interest to you;
 - 4.4.4 contact for market research purposes which may be done using email, telephone, fax or mail. Such information may be used to customise or update the Website.
- 4.5 The security of your Data is important to us. We maintain appropriate technical and physical safeguards to protect your Data against accidental or unlawful destruction or loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure or access, use and all other unlawful forms of processing of the data in our possession. We use the same level of skill in protecting your Data as other similar games developers. However, since the internet is not a completely secure environment we cannot guarantee that information you transmit via our Games will not be accessed, disclosed, altered or destroyed by breach of any of our safeguards.

5. Third Party Websites and Services

- 5.1 MGC may, from time to time, employ the services of other parties for dealing with matters that may include, but are not limited to, payment processing, delivery of purchased items, search engine facilities, advertising and marketing. The providers of such services have access to certain personal Data provided by Users of this Website.
- 5.2 Any Data used by such parties is used only to the extent required by them to perform the services that MGC requests. Any use for other purposes is strictly prohibited. Furthermore, any Data that is processed by third parties shall be processed within the terms of this Policy and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

6. Links to Other Websites

This Website may, from time to time, provide links to other websites. MGC has no control over such websites and is in no way responsible for the content thereof. This Policy does not extend to your use of such websites. Users are advised to read the privacy policy or statement of other websites prior to using them.

7. Changes of Business Ownership and Control

- 7.1 MGC may, from time to time, expand or reduce our business and this may involve the sale and/or the transfer of control of all or part of MGC. Data provided by Users will, where it is relevant to any part of our business so transferred, be transferred along with that part and the new owner or newly controlling party will, under the terms of this Policy, be permitted to use the Data for the purposes for which it was originally supplied to us.
- 7.2 In the event that any Data submitted by Users is to be transferred in such a manner, you will not be contacted in advance and informed of the changes.

8. Controlling Use of Your Data

- 8.1 Wherever you are required to submit Data, you will be given options to restrict our use of that Data. This may include the following:
 - 8.1.1 use of Data for direct marketing purposes; and
 - 8.1.2 sharing Data with third parties.

9. Your Right to Withhold Information

- 9.1 You may access certain areas of the Website without providing any Data at all. However, to use all features and functions available on the Website you may be required to submit certain Data.
- 9.2 You may restrict your internet browser's use of Cookies. For more information see Clause 12.

10. Accessing your own Data

You have the right to ask for a copy of any of your personal Data held by MGC (where such data is held) on payment of a small fee which will not exceed £5.

11. **Security**

Data security is of great importance to MGC and to protect your Data we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure Data collected via this Website.

12. **Cookies**

12.1 This Website may place and access certain Cookies on your computer. MGC uses Cookies to improve your experience of using the Website and to improve our range of products and/or services. MGC has carefully chosen these Cookies and has taken steps to ensure that your privacy is protected and respected at all times.

12.2 All Cookies used by this Website are used in accordance with current UK and EU Cookie Law.

12.3 Before the Website places any Cookies on your computer, you will be presented with a pop-up message bar requesting your consent to set those Cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of Cookies you are enabling MGC to provide the best possible experience and service to you. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of Cookies; however certain features of the Website may not function fully or as intended.

12.4 You can choose to enable or disable Cookies in your internet browser. By default, most internet browsers accept Cookies but this can be changed. For further details, please consult the help menu in your internet browser.

12.5 You can choose to delete Cookies at any time however you may lose any information that enables you to access the Website more quickly and efficiently including, but not limited to, personalisation settings.

12.6 It is recommended that you ensure that your internet browser is up-to-date and that you consult the help and guidance provided by the developer of your internet browser if you are unsure about adjusting your privacy settings.

13. **Changes to this Policy**

MGC reserves the right to change this Policy as we may deem necessary from time to time or as may be required by law. Any changes will be immediately posted on the Website and you are deemed to have accepted the terms of the Policy on your first use of the Website following the alterations.

14. **Children**

MGC believes that protecting the privacy of children on the Internet is very important. The Website and the services provided by MGC' software are not designed to attract children under the age of 13, and MGC does not intentionally collect personal information from such children. Ordering online products, services and information is limited to adults 18 or over. Children should exercise caution before providing personal information online and should discuss with an adult or guardian before doing so. MGC] also urges parents and guardians to consider using one of the low-cost programs designed to protect children while they are online.

We reserve the right to advertise our Services on mobile devices. Ad identifiers are non-permanent, non-personal, device identifiers such as the Android advertising ID and/or Apple's ID for advertising, or IDFA. When we advertise our Services on mobile devices, we may use your device's advertising identifier and other information associated with it, which we may hold ourselves or may be provided to us by our advertising network partners, to help us to deliver ads that relate to your interests and to improve and measure the effectiveness of ad campaigns.
